# I. SUMMARY OF PROJECT STATUS AND PROPOSED CHANGES

The Kenya Development Response to Displacement Impacts Project (Kenya DRDIP) was approved by the Board on April 26, 2017 and became effective on June 28, 2017. The National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU) has been established, the County Implementation Arrangements have been set up and the project has been launched in all the three project counties. The contracting of the Facilitating Partners (FPs) has been completed in all five project subcounties and the FPs have been introduced in pre-village entry stakeholder meetings. With the support of the FPs, communities in the five project sub-counties are at varying stages of finalizing the preparation of their Community Development Plans (CDPs), which will be followed by the preparation of the Annual Work Plans for Fiscal Year 2020/21. Field-level implementation of community sub-projects is expected to commence by Aug 1. Currently, the project has no outstanding audit reports.

Through the Kenya DRDIP Multi-Donor Trust Fund (MDTF), the Danish International Development Agency (DANIDA) has extended additional grant funding to the project. The respective Grant Agreement was signed on January 30, 2019 and is scheduled to close on June 30, 2020. However, grant funds were only accessible to the project from January 2020. Considering the significant amount of the unutilized grant proceeds and to ensure that the grant can support the implementation of community-level sub-projects as planned, an extension of the grant period was recommended by the joint technical and implementation support mission conducted in December 2019. The Government of Kenya (GoK) therefore requested a no-cost extension for a period of 12 months from June 30, 2020 to June 30, 2021, which is being processed through this restructuring. The closing date of the IDA credit remains April 29, 2022. The grant supporting IGAD under component 5 of this project is under a separate Financing Agreement, which is not affected by this restructuring.
