













	<b>Knowledge Support to Welfare Analysis of Private Sector Interventions</b>	CO-LEAD BY WB Poverty and Equity Group & IFC Sector Economics and Development Impact Department	By developing and piloting analytical frameworks and models to systematically assess private sector contributions to poverty reduction, this project builds models for 4-6 pilot countries including <b>Rwanda, Tunisia, and Brazil</b> .
	<b>Investment Matching Platform for Refugee Communities in Jordan</b>	CO-LEAD BY WB External and Corporate Relations Global Engagement & Partnerships Team; and WB Equitable Growth, Finance and Institutions Group (Mena Region)	This project aims to facilitate \$30 million in investments by convening local businesses, global corporations, foundations, philanthropic investors, and the development community to create opportunities for local SMEs in <b>Jordan</b> , that are owned by, employing, or delivering services to refugees and host communities.
