### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Ministry of Health met all disbursement linked results due to be completed prior to June 30, 2019, which provided the basic policy and operational guidance necessary for the PHC reorganization and strengthening activities supported, in part, by the Project. These included important policy decisions endorsing the Essential Service Package to be provided by primary health care facilities, the process of empaneling and registering the population to a specific primary health care provider, clinical protocols for quality non-communicable disease detection and management, and community engagement guidelines. Given this progress in the first year of project implementation, the project is rated as satisfactory.

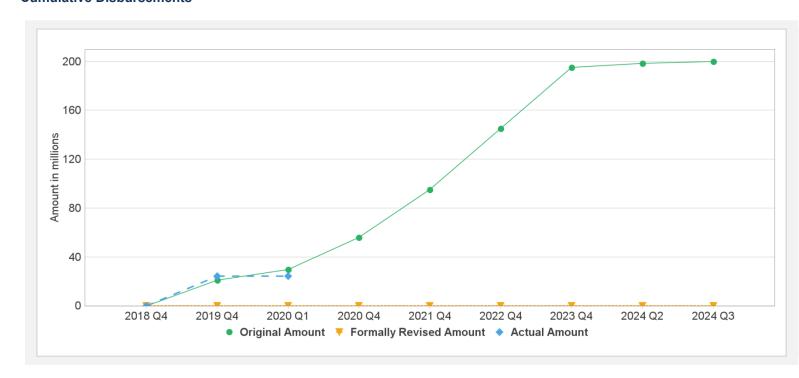
