Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The World Bank approved the NRETP in April 2018, and the Financing Agreement was signed on 5th March 2019. The project was declared effective on April 24, 2019. The total cost of the project is US\$ 500 million, of which the World Bank financing is US\$ 250 million. The project is building on the prior investments made under NRLP and supports the NRLM. The emphasis under this second phase is on the promotion of women-owned and women-led farm and non-farm enterprises across value chains, which will help rural households shift to a higher order of economic initiatives. Initially, the project period was planned for five years; however, due to delayed signing, the project is effectively left with four years of implementation period. In the immediate aftermath of the lockdown, NRLM has responded across all states with innovations to enable the continued functioning and in some cases the expansion of local enterprises. For example, app enabled local food supply chains were mobilized in Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand, Kerala, Odisha, Rural retail stores were kept stocked with essentials in Bihar; Canteens to feed the vulnerable were mobilized in Bihar, Odisha, Kerala, Jharkhand and there was a rapid conversion of capacity to produce personal safety items: masks, sanitizers

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(multiple states), with earning potential (private sector & government procurement) across states. Some states such as West Bengal maintained procurement channels open for SHG households; states such as Bihar carried out rapid identification of vulnerable households without access to safety nets; many SRLMs are engaged in skills surveys for returning migrants. States such as UP, Bihar are showing strong support for scaling up female banking agents, a policy that NRLP/NRETP has been supporting.

An NRLP impact evaluation has been completed by 3ie and finds that project has had significant success in targeting poor households, improving social inclusion and in narrowing caste-based differences in access to resources. The analysis also suggests that mobilizing SHGs into higher order federations generate larger effects on loans as well as on productive assets. In addition, rating tools for cluster level federations have been developed and are being applied. Increased focus on the implementation of activities to strengthen the cluster level federations, producer groups and enterprises will be required over the coming six months to build back and scale up economic growth.
