Comments:	This indicator will track the number of legal and regulatory draft acts that were developed through the assistance provided under the Project. The end target of five (5) includes: draft Petroleum Commission Act; draft Petroleum Taxation and Fiscal Regulations; draft Local Content Law and Regulations [for petroleum sector]; draft Occupational Safety and Health Regulations [for petroleum sector]; draft Environmental Regulations [for petroleum sector]. As of July 2020, an internationally recognized legal consultant firm has been hired to support the development of the legal and regulatory frameworks for the O&G sector but no work has started. The GPRGMP has in the meantime financed a legal workshop and crude lifting workshop both with international experts for key government representatives.


