Dear Dr. Segenet Kelemu,

We refer to: (i) the Financing Agreement (Grant Number D347-3A) dated August 1, 2018 between International Centre for Insect Physiology and Ecology (the “Recipient”) and the International Development Association (the “Association”) (the “Financing Agreement”); (ii) the Grant Agreement (TF0A8639) dated October 27, 2018, between the Recipient and International Development Association acting as Administrator of Korea World Bank Group Facility Single-Donor Trust Fund for the Regional Initiative for Applied Sciences, Engineering and Technology in Africa (the “Bank”); and (iii) the Grant Agreement (TF0B1033) dated September 22, 2019, between the Recipient and the Bank, all for the above-referenced Project. We also refer to your letter dated June 4, 2021 requesting the Bank to consider key issues discussed at the Project’s mid-term review, which was conducted in April 2021.

We are pleased to inform you that the Bank agrees to amend the above agreements as follows:

“2. The Closing Date is December 31, 2025.”

3. KWGPF Grant Agreement - TF0B1033

(a) The objective of the Project, in the “Project Description” under Schedule 1 to the Grant Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

“To strengthen the institutional capacity for quality doctoral training, research, and innovation in transformative technologies in Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA).”

(b) Section III.B.2 of Schedule 2 to the Grant Agreement is amended to read as follows:

“2. The Closing Date is December 31, 2025.”
