LOAN AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT, dated March 31, 1999, between MALAYSIA (the Borrower) and INTERNATIONAL BANK FOR RECONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT (the Bank).

WHEREAS (A) the Borrower, having satisfied itself as to the feasibility and priority of the project described in Schedule 2 to this Agreement (the Project), has requested the Bank to assist in the financing of the Project;

the Borrower intends to contract from United Nations Development Program (UNDP) a grant in an amount equivalent to one million Dollars (the UNDP Grant) to assist in the financing of Part D.1 of the Project, on the terms and conditions set forth in an agreement to be entered into between the Borrower and UNDP (the UNDP Project Document); and

WHEREAS the Bank has agreed, on the basis, inter alia, of the foregoing, to extend the Loan to the Borrower upon the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

General Conditions; Definitions

Section 1.01. The "General Conditions Applicable to Loan and Guarantee Agreements for Single Currency Loans" of the Bank, dated May 30, 1995 (as amended

Public Disclosure Authorized

through December 2, 1997) (the General Conditions) constitute an integral part of this Agreement.

Section 1.02. Unless the context otherwise requires, the several terms defined in the General Conditions and in the Preamble to this Agreement have the respective meanings therein set forth and the following additional terms have the following meanings:

- (a) "Affected Person" means a person who, on account of the execution of the Project, has or would have his or her: (i) standard of living adversely affected; (ii) right, title or interest in any house, land (including premises, agricultural and grazing land) or any other fixed or movable asset acquired or possessed, temporarily or permanently; or (iii) business, occupation, work or place of residence or habitat adversely affected.
- (b) "EPU" means the Economic Planning Unit of the Borrower's Prime Minister's Department, and any successor thereto.
- (c) "Guidelines for Land Acquisition and Resettlement" means the framework prepared by the Borrower, in agreement with the Bank, for the provision of compensation to Affected Persons as set forth in paragraph 3 of Schedule 5 to this Agreement, and as such Guidelines may be amended from time to time in agreement with the Bank.
- (d) "Hard Core Poor" means households with an income level below fifty percent of the Poverty Line.
- (e) "MNUSD" means the Borrower's Ministry of National Unity and Social Development, and any successor thereto.
 - (f) "MOH" means the Borrower's Ministry of Health, and any successor thereto.
- (g) "MORD" means that Borrower's Ministry of Rural Development, and any successor thereto.
- (h) "National Economic Recovery Plan" means the July 21, 1998 comprehensive framework for economic recovery issued by the Borrower's National Economic Action Council.
 - (i) "Poor" means households with an income level below the Poverty Line.
- (j) "Poverty Districts" means the sixty-six districts specified in MORD's December 1998 list of poorest districts in the Borrower's territory; and "Poverty District" means any of the Poverty Districts.
- (k) "Poverty Line" means the equivalent of two international dollars at 1985 prices, or such other amount as may be determined by the Borrower from time to time.
- (1) "Project Management Report" means each report prepared in accordance with Section 4.02 of this Agreement.
- (m) "Project Ministries" means, collectively, the MNUSD, MOH and MORD; and "Project Ministry" means any of the Project Ministries.
- (n) "Special Account" means the account referred to in Section 2.02(b) of this Agreement.

ARTICLE II

The Loan

- Section 2.01. The Bank agrees to lend to the Borrower, on the terms and conditions set forth or referred to in the Loan Agreement, an amount equal to sixty million Dollars (\$60,000,000).
- Section 2.02. (a) The amount of the Loan may be withdrawn from the Loan Account in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 1 to this Agreement for expenditures made (or, if the Bank shall so agree, to be made) in respect of the

reasonable cost of goods and services required for the Project and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan.

- (b) The Borrower may, for the purposes of the Project, open and maintain in Dollars a special deposit account in a commercial bank, on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Bank, including appropriate protection against set-off, seizure or attachment. Deposits into, and payments out of the Special Account shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 6 to this Agreement.
- Section 2.03. The Closing Date shall be December 31, 2002, or such later date as the Bank shall establish. The Bank shall promptly notify the Borrower of such later date.
- Section 2.04. The Borrower shall pay to the Bank a fee in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the amount of the Loan. On or promptly after the Effective Date, the Bank shall, on behalf of the Borrower, withdraw from the Loan Account and pay to itself the amount of said fee.
- Section 2.05. The Borrower shall pay to the Bank a commitment charge at the rate of three-fourths of one percent (3/4 of 1%) per annum on the principal amount of the Loan not withdrawn from time to time.
- Section 2.06. The Borrower shall pay interest on the principal amount of the Loan withdrawn and outstanding from time to time in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 3 to this Agreement.
- Section 2.07. Interest and other charges shall be payable in arrears on June 15 and December 15 in each year. Section 2.08. The Borrower shall repay the principal amount of the Loan in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 3 to this Agreement.

ARTICLE III

Execution of the Project

- Section 3.01. (a) The Borrower declares its commitment to the objectives of the Project, and, to this end, shall carry out: (i) Part A of the Project through MORD; (ii) Part B of the Project through MOH; (iii) Part C of the Project through MNUSD; (iv) Part D.1 of the Project through EPU and the Project Ministries; and (v) Part D.2 of the Project through EPU, with due diligence and efficiency and in conformity with appropriate administrative, environmental, financial, health and technical practices, and shall provide, or cause to be provided, promptly as needed, the funds, facilities, services and other resources required for the Project.
- (b) Without limitation upon the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Section and except as the Borrower and the Bank shall otherwise agree, the Borrower shall carry out the Project in accordance with the Implementation Program set forth in Schedule 5 to this Agreement.
- Section 3.02. Except as the Bank shall otherwise agree, procurement of the goods, works and consultants' services required for the Project and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan shall be governed by the provisions of Schedule 4 to this Agreement.
- Section 3.03. For the purposes of Section 9.08 of the General Conditions and without limitation thereto, the Borrower shall:
- (a) prepare, on the basis of guidelines acceptable to the Bank, and furnish to the Bank not later than six (6) months before the Closing Date or such later date as may be agreed for this purpose between the Borrower and the Bank, a plan designed to ensure the continued achievement of the Project's objectives; and
- (b) afford the Bank a reasonable opportunity to exchange views with the Borrower on said plan.

ARTICLE IV

Financial Covenants

Section 4.01. (a) The Borrower shall maintain a financial management system, including records and accounts, and prepare financial statements in a format acceptable to the Bank, adequate to reflect the operations, resources and expenditures related to the Project.

(b) The Borrower shall:

- (i) have the records, accounts and financial statements referred to in paragraph (a) of this Section and the records and accounts for the Special Account for each fiscal year audited, in accordance with auditing standards acceptable to the Bank, consistently applied, by independent auditors acceptable to the Bank;
- (ii) furnish to the Bank as soon as available, but in any case not later than six

 (6) months after the end of each such year, (A) certified copies of the financial statements referred to in paragraph (a) of this Section for such year as so audited, and (B) an opinion on such statements, records and accounts and report of such audit, by said auditors, of such scope and in such detail as the Bank shall have reasonably requested; and
- (iii) furnish to the Bank such other information concerning such records and accounts, and the audit thereof, and concerning said auditors, as the Bank may from time to time reasonably request.
- (c) For all expenditures with respect to which withdrawals from the Loan Account were made on the basis of statement of expenditures, the Borrower shall:
- (i) maintain or cause to be maintained, in accordance with paragraph (a) of this Section, records and separate accounts reflecting such expenditures;
- (ii) retain, until at least one year after the Bank has received the audit report for the fiscal year in which the last withdrawal from the Loan Account was made, all records (contracts, orders, invoices, bills, receipts and other documents) evidencing such expenditures;
 - (iii) enable the Bank's representatives to examine such records; and
- (iv) ensure that such records and accounts are included in the annual audit referred to in paragraph (b) of this Section and that the report of such audit contains a separate opinion by said auditors as to whether the statements of expenditure submitted during such fiscal year, together with the procedures and internal controls involved in their preparation, can be relied upon to support the related withdrawals.
- Section 4.02. (a) Without limitation upon the provisions of Section 4.01 of this Agreement, the Borrower shall carry out a time-bound action plan acceptable to the Bank for the strengthening of the financial management system referred to in paragraph (a) of said Section 4.01 in order to enable the Borrower, not later than July 1, 2000, or such later date as the Bank shall agree, to prepare quarterly Project management reports, acceptable to the Bank, each of which:
- (i) (A) sets forth actual sources and applications of funds for the Project, both cumulatively and for the period covered by said report, and projected sources and applications of funds for the Project for the six-month period following the period covered by said report, and (B) shows separately expenditures financed out of the proceeds of the Loan during the period covered by said report and expenditures proposed to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan during the six-month period following the period covered by said report;
- (ii) (A) describes physical progress in Project implementation, both cumulatively and for the period covered by said report, and (B) explains

variances between the actual and previously forecast implementation targets; and

- (iii) sets forth the status of procurement under the Project and expenditures under contracts financed out of the proceeds of the Loan, as at the end of the period covered by said report.
- (b) Upon the completion of the action plan referred to in paragraph (a) of this Section, the Borrower shall prepare, in accordance with guidelines acceptable to the Bank, and furnish to the Bank not later than 45 days after the end of each calendar quarter a Project Management Report for such period.

ARTICLE V

Remedies of the Bank

Section 5.01. Pursuant to Section 6.02(p) of the General Conditions, the following additional events are specified:

- (a) The UNDP Project Document shall have failed to become effective by September 1, 1999, or such later date as the Bank may agree; provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply if the Borrower establishes to the satisfaction of the Bank that adequate funds for Part D.1 of the Project are available to the Borrower from other sources on terms and conditions consistent with the obligations of the Borrower under this Agreement.
- (b) (i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the right of the Borrower to withdraw the proceeds of the UNDP Grant shall have been suspended, canceled or terminated in whole or in part, pursuant to the terms of the UNDP Project Document, or
- (ii) Subparagraph (i) of this paragraph shall not apply if the Borrower establishes to the satisfaction of the Bank that: (A) such suspension, cancellation or termination is not caused by the failure of the Borrower to perform any of its obligations under such agreement; and (B) adequate funds for Part D.1 of the Project are available to the Borrower from other sources on terms and conditions consistent with the obligations of the Borrower under this Agreement.
- Section 5.02. Pursuant to Section 7.01(k) of the General Conditions, the following additional events are specified:
- (a) The event specified in paragraph (a) of Section 5.01 of this Agreement shall occur.
- (b) The event specified in paragraph (b)(i) of Section 5.01 of this Agreement shall occur, subject to the proviso of paragraph (b)(ii) of that Section.

ARTICLE VI

Effective Date; Termination

Section 6.01. The following events are specified as additional conditions to the effectiveness of the Loan Agreement within the meaning of Section 12.01(c) of the General Conditions:

- (a) The Borrower shall have appointed, in accordance with paragraph 1 of Schedule 5 to this Agreement, a person in each of the Project Ministries to be responsible for Project accounting functions.
- (b) The Borrower's Accountant General shall have issued procedural and management guidelines for the Special Account, satisfactory to the Bank, and which guidelines shall have been adopted by the Project Ministries.
- Section 6.02. The date ninety (90) days after the date of this Agreement is hereby specified for the purposes of Section 12.04 of the General Conditions.

ARTICLE VII

Representative of the Borrower; Addresses

Section 7.01. The Secretary General to the Treasury, Ministry of Finance of the Borrower, is designated as representative of the Borrower for the purposes of Section 11.03 of the General Conditions.

- 2. For the purposes of this Schedule:
- (a) the term "foreign expenditures" means expenditures in the currency of any country other than that of the Borrower for goods or services supplied from the territory of any country other than that of the Borrower; and
- (b) the term "local expenditures" means expenditures in the currency of the Borrower or for goods or services supplied from the territory of the Borrower.
- 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1 above, no withdrawals shall be made in respect of payments made for expenditures prior to the date of this Agreement, except that withdrawals, in an aggregate amount not exceeding \$6,000,000, may be made in respect of Categories (1), (2) and (3) set forth in the table in paragraph 1 of this Schedule on account of payments made for expenditures before that date but after January 1, 1999.
- 4. The Bank may require withdrawals from the Loan Account to be made on the basis of statements of expenditure for expenditures for:
 - (a) works under contracts costing less than \$100,000 equivalent each;
 - (b) goods under contracts costing less than \$100,000 equivalent each;
- (c) consultants' services under contracts with consulting firms costing less than \$100,000 equivalent each (excluding contracts with consulting firms procured in accordance with the provisions of Part C.3 of Section II to Schedule 4); and
- (d) consultants' services under contracts with individual consultants costing less than \$50,000 equivalent each, all under such terms and conditions as the Bank shall specify by notice to the Borrower.

SCHEDULE 2

Description of the Project

The objective of the Project is to assist the Borrower in ameliorating the adverse impacts of the regional economic crisis, through: (a) implementation of the National Economic Recovery Plan strategy to ensure continued access of the Poor to essential social services, especially in the poorest districts; and (b) poverty monitoring and monitoring of the effectiveness of social programs in alleviating poverty and their impacts.

The Project consists of the following parts, subject to such modifications thereof as the Borrower and the Bank may agree upon from time to time to achieve such objectives:

- Part A. Rural Development and Poverty Alleviation
- 1. Promoting early childhood development of pre-school children in Poverty Districts by constructing and equipping about 400 education facilities and renovating and updating equipment in about 1,300 education facilities.
- 2. Supporting the overall development of the Hard Core Poor through construction and rehabilitation of community facilities (excluding religious facilities) and provision of vocational skills training, special tutoring and counseling in about 60 villages in Poverty Districts.

Part B. Health Services

1. Expanding access to basic health care, particularly for vulnerable groups, such

as mothers and children, through construction and equipping of about 31 rural community clinics and about 10 urban health clinics in areas without access to adequate health services.

- Part C. Social Assistance for Disadvantaged groups
- 1. Supporting ongoing welfare programs of MNUSD through: (a) refurbishment and equipping of about 68 shelters for the elderly and orphans; (b) construction and equipping of about 150 new and refurbishing of about 500 existing kindergartens for the Poor; (c) construction of about 120 day care centers for the elderly; (d) construction and equipping of 7 women's centers; and (e) provision of training for caregivers and teachers.
- Part D. Poverty Monitoring and Impact Assessment
- 1. Strengthening the Borrower's capacity to assess the social effects of crises and the effectiveness of countervailing measures, through quantitative and qualitative monitoring of poverty and in-depth evaluation of poverty reduction programs.
- 2. Enhancing the Borrower's ability to plan effective poverty reduction programs through an evaluation of its poverty monitoring and impact assessment capabilities.

The Project is expected to be completed by June 30, 2002.

SCHEDULE 3

Interest and Principal Repayment Provisions

A. General Definitions

For purposes of this Schedule, the following terms have the following meanings:

- (a) "Disbursed Amount" means, in respect of each Interest Period, the aggregate principal amount of the Loan withdrawn from the Loan Account in such Interest Period.
- (b) "Interest Period" means the initial period from and including the date of this Agreement to, but excluding, the first Interest Payment Date occurring thereafter, and after the initial period, each period from and including an Interest Payment date to, but excluding, the next following Interest Payment Date.
- (c) "Interest Payment Date" means any date specified in Section 2.07 of this Agreement.
- (d) "Rate Fixing Date" means, for each Disbursed Amount, the first day of the Interest Period next following the Interest Period in which such Disbursed Amount is withdrawn.

B. Interest

- 1. The principal amount of the Loan shall be divided into Disbursed Amounts. Interest shall accrue on each Disbursed Amount outstanding from time to time at a rate based on a floating rate index prior to its Rate Fixing Date and at a fixed rate from its Rate Fixing Date, as described in paragraph 2 of this Part B.
- 2. (a) From the date of withdrawal of each amount of each Disbursed Amount withdrawn and outstanding, to but not including the Rate Fixing Date for such Disbursed Amount, interest on each such amount shall accrue, at a rate equal to the applicable:
 - (i) LIBOR Base Rate; plus
 - (ii) LIBOR Total Spread.
 - (b) From the Rate Fixing Date for each Disbursed Amount until final repayment

thereof, interest on such Disbursed Amount shall accrue, at a rate equal to the applicable:

- (i) Fixed Base Rate; plus
- (ii) Fixed Total Spread.
- 3. For purposes of paragraph 2 of this Part B, the following terms have the following meanings:
- (a) "LIBOR Base Rate" means, for the Interest Period in which a Disbursed Amount is withdrawn, the London interbank offered rate for six-month deposits in Dollar for value the first day of such Interest Period (or, in the case of the initial Interest Period, for value the day occurring on the Interest Payment Date preceding the first day of such Interest Period), as reasonably determined by the Bank and expressed as a percentage per annum.
- (b) "LIBOR Total Spread" means, for the Interest Period in which each Disbursed Amount is withdrawn:
 - (i) three fourths of one percent (3/4 of 1%);
- (ii) minus (or plus) the weighted average margin, for such Interest
 Period, below (or above) the London interbank offered rates, or
 other reference rates, for six-month deposits, in respect of the
 Bank's outstanding borrowings or portions thereof allocated by the
 Bank to fund single currency loans or portions thereof made by
 it that include such Disbursed Amount for such Interest
 Period; as reasonably determined by the Bank and expressed as a
 percentage per annum.
- (c) "Fixed Base Rate" means, for each Disbursed Amount, the equivalent of the London interbank offered rate for six-month deposits in Dollars for value on the Rate Fixing Date for such Disbursed Amount, expressed as a single fixed interest rate based on the fixed interest rates corresponding to the repayment installments of such Disbursed Amount, as reasonably determined by the Bank and expressed as a percentage per annum.
 - (d) "Fixed Total Spread" means, for each Disbursed Amount:
 - (i) three fourths of one percent (3/4 of 1%);
- (ii) minus (or plus) the cost margin, applicable on the Rate Fixing
 Date for such
 Disbursed Amount, below (or above) the London
 interbank offered rates, or
 other reference rates, for
 six-month deposits, in respect of the Bank's
 outstanding
 borrowings or portions thereof allocated to fund single currency
 or portions thereof made by it that include such Disbursed Amount; plus
- (iii) the Bank's risk spread applicable on the Rate Fixing Date for such Disbursed Amount; as reasonably determined by the Bank and expressed as a percentage per annum.
- 4. The Bank shall notify the Borrower of LIBOR Base Rate, LIBOR Total Spread, Fixed Base Rate and Fixed Total Spread applicable to each Disbursed Amount, promptly upon the determination thereof.
- 5. Whenever, in light of changes in market practice affecting the determination of the interest rates referred to in this Schedule, the Bank determines that it is in the interest of its borrowers as a whole and of the Bank to apply a basis for determining the interest rates applicable to the Loan other than as provided in this Schedule, the Bank may modify the basis for determining the interest rates applicable to amounts of the Loan not yet withdrawn upon not less than six (6) months' notice to the Borrower of the new basis. The new basis shall become effective on the expiry of the notice period unless the Borrower notifies the Bank during said period of its objection thereto, in which case said modification shall not apply to the Loan.
- C. Repayment

- 1. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 2 of this Part C, the Borrower shall repay each Disbursed Amount of the Loan in semiannual installments payable on each June 15 and December 15, the first such installment to be payable on the seventh (7th) Interest Payment Date following the Rate Fixing Date for such Disbursed Amount and the last such installment to be payable on the twenty-fourth (24th) Interest Payment Date following the Rate Fixing Date for such Disbursed Amount. Each installment shall be one-eighteenth (1/18) of such Disbursed Amount.
- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 1 of this Part C, if any installment of principal of each Disbursed Amount would, pursuant to the provisions of said paragraph 1, be payable after December 15, 2014, the Borrower shall also pay on said date the aggregate amount of all such installments.
- 3. After each Disbursed Amount shall have been withdrawn, the Bank shall promptly notify the Borrower of the amortization schedule for such Disbursed Amount.

SCHEDULE 4

Procurement

Section I. Procurement of Goods and Works

Part A: General

Goods and works shall be procured in accordance with the provisions of Section I of the "Guidelines for Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits" published by the Bank in January 1995 and revised in January and August 1996, September 1997 and January 1999 (the Guidelines) and the following provisions of Section I of this Schedule.

Part B: International Competitive Bidding

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in Part C of this Section, goods shall be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of Section II of the Guidelines and paragraph 5 of Appendix 1 thereto.
- 2. The following provisions shall apply to goods to be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of this Part B.
 - (a) Grouping of contracts

To the extent practicable, contracts for goods shall be grouped in bid packages estimated to cost \$200,000 equivalent or more each.

(b) Preference for domestically manufactured goods

The provisions of paragraphs 2.54 and 2.55 of the Guidelines and Appendix 2 thereto shall apply to goods manufactured in the territory of the Borrower.

(c) Notification and Advertising

The invitation to prequalify or bid for each contract estimated to cost \$10,000,000 equivalent or more shall be advertised in accordance with the procedures applicable to large contracts under paragraph 2.8 of the Guidelines.

Part C: Other Procurement Procedures

- 1. National Competitive Bidding
- (a) Each contract for goods estimated to cost less than \$200,000 equivalent per contract, up to an aggregate amount not to exceed \$3,330,000 equivalent, may be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.3 and 3.4 of the Guidelines.
- (b) Each contract for works estimated to cost \$100,000 equivalent or more per contract, up to an aggregate amount not to exceed \$27,010,000 equivalent, shall be

procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.3 and 3.4 of the Guidelines.

2. National Shopping Goods estimated to cost less than \$100,000 equivalent per contract, up to an aggregate amount not to exceed \$11,090,000 equivalent, may be procured under contracts awarded on the basis of national shopping procedures in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.5 and 3.6 of the Guidelines.

3. Direct Contracting

Goods that must be purchased from the original supplier to be compatible with existing equipment or are of a proprietary nature may, with the Bank's prior agreement, be procured in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3.7 of the Guidelines.

4. Procurement of Small Works

Works estimated to cost less than \$100,000 equivalent per contract, up to an aggregate amount not to exceed \$23,300,000 equivalent, may be procured under lump-sum, fixed-price contracts awarded on the basis of quotations obtained from three (3) qualified domestic contractors in response to a written invitation. The invitation shall include a detailed description of the works, including basic specifications, the required completion date, a basic form of agreement acceptable to the Bank, and relevant drawings, where applicable. The award shall be made to the contractor who offers the lowest price quotation for the required work, and who has the experience and resources to complete the contract successfully.

Part D: Review by the Bank of Procurement Decisions

1. Procurement Planning

Prior to the issuance of any invitations to bid for contracts, the proposed procurement plan for the Project shall be furnished to the Bank for its review and approval, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of Appendix 1 to the Guidelines. Procurement of all goods and works shall be undertaken in accordance with such procurement plan as shall have been approved by the Bank, and with the provisions of said paragraph 1.

2. Prior Review

- (a) The procedures set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 of Appendix 1 to the Guidelines shall apply with respect to the following contracts:
- (i) the first three contracts for works to be procured by each of the Project Ministries and estimated to cost the equivalent of \$100,000 or more per contract; and
- (ii) the first three contracts for goods to be procured by each of the Project Ministries and estimated to cost the equivalent of \$100,000\$ or more per contract.

3. Post Review

With respect to each contract not governed by paragraph 2 of this Part, the procedures set forth in paragraph 4 of Appendix 1 to the Guidelines shall apply.

Section II. Employment of Consultants

Part A: General

Consultants' services shall be procured in accordance with the provisions of the Introduction and Section IV of the "Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers" published by the Bank in January 1997 and revised in September 1997 and January 1999 (the Consultant Guidelines) and the following provisions of Section II of this Schedule.

Part B: Quality- and Cost-based Selection

1. Except as otherwise provided in Part C of this Section, consultants' services shall be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of Section II of the Consultant Guidelines, paragraph 3 of Appendix 1 thereto, Appendix 2 thereto, and the provisions of paragraphs 3.13 through 3.18 thereof applicable to quality- and cost-based selection of consultants.

Part C: Other Procedures for the Selection of Consultants

1. Quality-based Selection

Services under Part C of the Project estimated to cost more than \$100,000 equivalent per contract may be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.1 through 3.4 of the Consultant Guidelines.

2. Selection Based on Consultants' Oualifications

Services under Part C of the Project estimated to cost less than \$100,000 equivalent per contract may be procured under contracts awarded in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.1 and 3.7 of the Consultant Guidelines.

3. Single Source Selection

Services under Parts A and C of the Project, may, with the Bank's prior agreement, be procured in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3.8 through 3.11 of the Consultant Guidelines.

4. Individual Consultants

Services for under Parts A and C of the Project estimated to cost less than \$50,000 equivalent per contract and that meet the requirements set forth in paragraph 5.1 of the Consultant Guidelines shall be procured under contracts awarded to individual consultants in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 5.1 through 5.3 of the Consultant Guidelines.

Part D: Review by the Bank of the Selection of Consultants

1. Selection Planning

Prior to the issuance to consultants of any requests for proposals, the proposed plan for the selection of consultants under the Project shall be furnished to the Bank for its review and approval, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 1 of Appendix 1 to the Consultant Guidelines. Selection of all consultants' services shall be undertaken in accordance with such selection plan as shall have been approved by the Bank, and with the provisions of said paragraph 1.

2. Prior Review

- (a) With respect to each contract for the employment of consulting firms estimated to cost the equivalent of \$100,000 or more per contract, the procedures set forth in paragraphs 1, 2 and (other than the third subparagraph of paragraph 2(a)) and 5 of Appendix 1 to the Consultant Guidelines shall apply.
- (b) With respect to each contract to be procured in accordance with the provisions of Part C.3 of this Section II, the procedures set forth in paragraphs 1, 2 (other than the second subparagraph of paragraph 2(a)) and 5 of Appendix 1 to the Consultant Guidelines shall apply.
- (c) With respect to each contract for the employment of individual consultants estimated to cost the equivalent of \$50,000 or more, the qualifications, experience, terms of reference and terms of employment of the consultants shall be furnished to the Bank for its prior review and approval. The contract shall be awarded only after the said approval shall have been given.

3. Post Review

With respect to each contract not governed by paragraph 2 of this Part, the

procedures set forth in paragraph 4 of Appendix 1 to the Consultant Guidelines shall apply.

SCHEDULE 5

Implementation Program

Project Management

1. In order to ensure the proper carrying out of the Project, the Borrower shall appoint in each of the Project Ministries, a person with appropriate experience to be responsible for accounting functions relating to Project implementation and, thereafter, maintain said persons throughout the period of Project implementation, with terms of reference acceptable to the Bank.

Monitoring and Reporting

2. The Borrower shall:

- (a) maintain policies and procedures adequate to enable it to monitor and evaluate on an ongoing basis, in accordance with indicators acceptable to the Bank, the carrying out of the Project and the achievement of the objectives thereof;
- (b) prepare, under terms of reference acceptable to the Bank, and furnish to the Bank an annual report, not later than March 30 in each year, beginning on March 30, 2000, consisting of:
- (i) a summary of the monitoring and evaluation activities carried out by it pursuant to paragraph 2(a) of this Schedule 5 in respect of the preceding calendar year and setting forth proposed measures, indicated by said monitoring and evaluation activities, to further the objectives of the Project; and
- (ii) an annual action plan and proposed budget for Project implementation activities to be carried out in the current calendar year, and
- (c) by April 30 in each year, beginning on April 30, 2000, review with the Bank the report referred to in paragraph 2(b) of this Schedule 5 and promptly take all measures required to ensure the efficient completion of the Project and the achievement of the objectives thereof, based on the conclusions and recommendations of said report and the Bank's views on the matter.

Compensation for Affected Persons

- 3. In carrying out the Project:
- (a) the Borrower shall take measures to avoid or minimize the acquisition of land or assets of persons and to avoid the displacement of said persons;
- (b) where the acquisition of land or assets or the displacement of persons is unavoidable under the Project, the Borrower shall, before carrying out Project activities which would result in such acquisition or displacement, make available to such persons, compensation in accordance with the Guidelines for Land Acquisition and Resettlement agreed between the Borrower and the Bank; and
- (c) in the event that two hundred or more persons are adversely affected by said Project activities, the Borrower shall:
- (i) prepare a resettlement plan in accordance with the Guidelines for Land Acquisition and Resettlement and furnish such plan to the Bank for approval; and
- (ii) prior to the carrying out of said Project activities, ensure that all Affected Persons shall have been compensated in accordance with the provisions of said plan.

Part D of the Project

- 4. The Borrower shall carry out, in accordance with terms of reference acceptable to the Bank:
- (a) a quantitative assessment to measure the social impact of the economic crisis and furnish a report on its findings to the Bank by September 30, 1999;
- (b) a national participatory qualitative assessment of the impact of the economic crisis and furnish a report on its findings to the Bank by March 30, 2000;
- (c) at least two Project beneficiary assessments to evaluate the impact of and value derived from Project activities and furnish a report on its findings to the Bank by December 31, 2000; and
- (d) at least two in-depth impact evaluations to assess the effectiveness and cost of the Borrower's poverty reduction programs and furnish a report on its findings to the Bank by September 30, 2001.

SCHEDULE 6

Special Account

- 1. For the purposes of this Schedule:
- (a) the term "eligible Categories" means Categories (1), (2) and (3) set forth in the table in paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to this Agreement;
- (b) the term "eligible expenditures" means expenditures in respect of the reasonable cost of goods and services required for the Project and to be financed out of the proceeds of the Loan allocated from time to time to the eligible Categories in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 1 to this Agreement; and
- (c) the term "Authorized Allocation" means an amount equivalent to \$5,000,000 to be withdrawn from the Loan Account and deposited into the Special Account pursuant to paragraph 3 (a) of this Schedule, provided, however, that unless the Bank shall otherwise agree, the Authorized Allocation shall be limited to an amount equivalent to \$2,000,000 until the aggregate amount of withdrawals from the Loan Account plus the total amount of all outstanding special commitments entered into by the Bank pursuant to Section 5.02 of the General Conditions shall be equal to or exceed the equivalent of \$10,000,000.
- 2. Payments out of the Special Account shall be made exclusively for eligible expenditures in accordance with the provisions of this Schedule.
- 3. After the Bank has received evidence satisfactory to it that the Special Account has been duly opened, withdrawals of the Authorized Allocation and subsequent withdrawals to replenish the Special Account shall be made as follows:
- (a) For withdrawals of the Authorized Allocation, the Borrower shall furnish to the Bank a request or requests for deposit into the Special Account of an amount or amounts which do not exceed the aggregate amount of the Authorized Allocation. On the basis of such request or requests, the Bank shall, on behalf of the Borrower, withdraw from the Loan Account and deposit into the Special Account such amount or amounts as the Borrower shall have requested.
- (b) (i) For replenishment of the Special Account, the Borrower shall furnish to the Bank requests for deposits into the Special Account at such intervals as the Bank shall specify.
- (ii) Prior to or at the time of each such request, the Borrower shall furnish to the Bank the documents and other evidence required pursuant to paragraph 4 of this Schedule for the payment or payments in respect of which replenishment is requested. On the basis of each such request, the Bank shall, on behalf of the Borrower, withdraw from the Loan Account and deposit into the Special Account such amount as the Borrower shall have requested and as shall have been shown by said documents and

other evidence to have been paid out of the Special Account for eligible expenditures. All such deposits shall be withdrawn by the Bank from the Loan Account under the respective eligible Categories, and in the respective equivalent amounts, as shall have been justified by said documents and other evidence.

- 4. For each payment made by the Borrower out of the Special Account, the Borrower shall, at such time as the Bank shall reasonably request, furnish to the Bank such documents and other evidence showing that such payment was made exclusively for eligible expenditures.
- 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 3 of this Schedule, the Bank shall not be required to make further deposits into the Special Account:
- (a) if, at any time, the Bank shall have determined that all further withdrawals should be made by the Borrower directly from the Loan Account in accordance with the provisions of Article V of the General Conditions and paragraph (a) of Section 2.02 of this Agreement;
- (b) if the Borrower shall have failed to furnish to the Bank, within the period of time specified in Section 4.01 (b) (ii) of this Agreement, any of the audit reports required to be furnished to the Bank pursuant to said Section in respect of the audit of the records and accounts for the Special Account;
- (c) if, at any time, the Bank shall have notified the Borrower of its intention to suspend in whole or in part the right of the Borrower to make withdrawals from the Loan Account pursuant to the provisions of Section 6.02 of the General Conditions; or
- (d) once the total unwithdrawn amount of the Loan allocated to the eligible Categories, minus the total amount of all outstanding special commitments entered into by the Bank pursuant to Section 5.02 of the General Conditions with respect to the Project, shall equal the equivalent of twice the amount of the Authorized Allocation. Thereafter, withdrawal from the Loan Account of the remaining unwithdrawn amount of the Loan allocated to the eligible Categories shall follow such procedures as the Bank shall specify by notice to the Borrower. Such further withdrawals shall be made only after and to the extent that the Bank shall have been satisfied that all such amounts remaining on deposit in the Special Account as of the date of such notice will be utilized in making payments for eligible expenditures.
- 6. (a) If the Bank shall have determined at any time that any payment out of the Special Account: (i) was made for an expenditure or in an amount not eligible pursuant to paragraph 2 of this Schedule; or (ii) was not justified by the evidence furnished to the Bank, the Borrower shall, promptly upon notice from the Bank: (A) provide such additional evidence as the Bank may request; or (B) deposit into the Special Account (or, if the Bank shall so request, refund to the Bank) an amount equal to the amount of such payment or the portion thereof not so eligible or justified. Unless the Bank shall otherwise agree, no further deposit by the Bank into the Special Account shall be made until the Borrower has provided such evidence or made such deposit or refund, as the case may be.
- (b) If the Bank shall have determined at any time that any amount outstanding in the Special Account will not be required to cover further payments for eligible expenditures, the Borrower shall, promptly upon notice from the Bank, refund to the Bank such outstanding amount.
- (c) The Borrower may, upon notice to the Bank, refund to the Bank all or any portion of the funds on deposit in the Special Account.
- (d) Refunds to the Bank made pursuant to paragraphs 6 (a), (b) and (c) of this Schedule shall be credited to the Loan Account for subsequent withdrawal or for cancellation in accordance with the relevant provisions of this Agreement, including the General Conditions.
