

How do we calculate the amount of funds leveraged?

As part of our ongoing monitoring of the ELP portfolio, we track the ways in which ELP finds invested leverage other sources of funding. Typically, funding leveraged can be generated into the three categories presented in the table below: developing new ECD activities; integrating ECD into planned projects; or, ensuring quality and evidence-based approaches. Most investments leverage funding within one or more of the three categories over their lifetime, but given the project development cycle, it may take several years to achieve leverage.
