## Implementation Status Overview

This Project closed on June 30 2011 with 100 percent disbursement rate and most of planned activities completed. Both Project Development Objectives and Implementation Performance are satisfactory. The Project was instrumental in supporting the country progress towards universal primary education. The US\$ 3.6m supported the construction of 22 new classrooms in primary education, allowing for the enrollment of additional 1,500 children, and 16 classrooms in early childhood education, the pre-service training of 60 new

teachers, in-service training of 350 teachers, purchase and distribution of 200,000 textbooks for primary education students, and various training activities addressed to technical staff of the education sector.





## **Key Decisions Regarding Implementation**

Building on the success of the Project, the Government has requested a second FTI Project, and has asked the World Bank to continue to be the Supervising Entity. However, the potential financial allocation announced for Sao Tome and Principe by the Global Partnership Education Fund (GPEF) is so low (US\$ 0.5 m) that it might not be suitable to put all the required efforts and resources for the preparation of a 0.5m Project.
