



RESEARCH ON BEHAVIORS IN NORTHERN LAO FOUND;



INFANTS TOUCHING DIRTY SURFACES OR OBJECTS AND THEN PUTTING THEIR HANDS IN THEIR MOUTHS, RATHER THAN PROVIDING A CLEAN PLAY AREA TO LIMIT THEIR EXPOSURE.. CAREGIVERS SELDOM WASHED HANDS WITH SOAP BEFORE PREPARING OR SERVING FOOD,



INSTEAD OF ONLY DOING SO AFTER WASHING HANDS WITH SOAP.




FINALLY, MANY MOTHERS RETURNED TO WORK SHORTLY AFTER BIRTH,

WHICH INTERFERED WITH THEIR ABILITY TO PRACTICE EXCLUSIVE BREASTFEEDING.



THESE DIFFERENCES WERE USED TO DESIGN A SET OF BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS.
